

NCAWPA Guidelines for Small Boat Rack Space Rentals

- Due to limited storage, members are limited to being assigned one rack space maximum
- Once assigned a space, members will maintain their rack provided they are active members of NCAWPA in good standing
 - "active" refers to a member who is current in their membership and rack payment and is actively involved in NCAWPA activities, either team participation or other supportive/programming activities.
- OC2s can only be stored on rack space A, the set of racks closest to the bay 4 door
- Rack fees must be paid promptly each year with membership payment
 - Rack rental fees are not waived for coaches
 - Rack spaces are assigned to one member and rack fees are paid by that member
 - Failure to pay for a renewed rack space will result in forfeiture of the space. The expectation is the fee will be paid by March 1st.
 - The member may opt to share the space with others but is responsible for making their own arrangements to share the cost.
 - The member may not share his/her rack space with a non-member
- When a rack space is no longer needed by the assigned member, they must email the rack space manager (rackmgr@ncawpa.org) to make him/her aware of the need to reassign space.
 - The assigned member may not "give" the space to another member; however, if the rack space is shared, preference for reassignment will go to the other party provided s/he is a member in good standing.
 - Rack space between two members who have assigned racks may be traded. This must be communicated to the rack space manager.
- When the rack spaces are full, a waitlist will be maintained for those members wishing to rent a space
 - The waitlist order will be determined by a member's indication of wanting to be placed on the waitlist for a rack space and the date of membership payment
 - Those that become interested in a space later in the year should reach out to the rack space manager to get placed on the waitlist
- New assignments of a rack space will be communicated by email to the first person on the waitlist by the rack space manager
 - Once a member is alerted that they have a space assigned, they have one week to indicate they want the space and to make payment to NCAWPA
 - If payment is not received within a week, the space will be forfeited and offered to the next person on the waitlist
- The small boat manager will ask for a description of all the boats on a person's rack for awareness and to facilitate communication as needed.
